To increase reading proficiency by 10%, in grades 6-8. The school will concentrate on developing vocabulary to interpret words and phrases as they are used in text and analyze how specific word choices shape meaning and tone.

To increase math proficiency by 10%, in grades 6-8. The school will concentrate on solving real-world and mathematical problems.

School - 6th - 8th grade classroom teachers agree and will work with students and their families to support students' success in reading and math. We will connect learning between school and families by:

- Providing high quality curriculum and instruction (including hands-on and interactive strategies) that enable students to meet high standards in reading and math.
- Communicating effectively and frequently regarding curriculum, assessments, performance results, interpreting results and grades, through grade distribution, remediation, report cards, newsletters, parent-teacher conferences, Edline and texting.
- Notifying parents of events and news through newsletter, flyers, marquee, automated phone calls, posters, Edline, texting, and school website www.okeeheelee.org.
- Offering free Family Nights concentrating on vocabulary building, and real-world problem and mathematical problem solving strategies.
- Providing links to family friendly websites for building vocabulary and solving real-world and mathematical problem and a progress log to monitor students' practice on vocabulary and problem solving website.
- Providing ongoing opportunities for parents to meet and share experiences and decisions related to the education of their children.

- Working with my parent to master the recommended list of literary terms, and complete or read at least 30 minutes each week of vocabulary practice or reading assignment.
- The school will concentrate on solving real-world and mathematical problems.
- Coming to school every day, on time, ready to learn and following all school and district rules and procedures.
- Using the free academic tutorial services provided by the teachers and/or the school and monitor personal Edline account daily.
- Bringing home notices of our Family Nights.
- Completing all required academic assignments (projects, classwork, homework, and assessments)
- Reporting dangerous situations or problems to the school and/or to parents.


- Asistir a la escuela regularmente, llegar a tiempo, estar preparado, obedecer las reglas de la escuela y mostrar respeto a todas las personas.
